BACKGROUND

The City Clerk's Office received a request from Joe Zito, VP Operations, Rainbow Centre for an exemption to Chapter 776 of the former City of Sudbury Municipal Code (Noise) to carry out sandblasting activity taking place at the Rainbow Centre between 8 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. They are unable to close the parking lot during business hours as this would result in a large inconvenience to mall patrons and monthly parkers.

The following dates are scheduled for sandblasting:

August 9, 10, August 13 to August 17, August 20 to August 24, August 27 to August 31, September 3 to September 7, September 10 to September 14, September 17 to September 21 and September 24 to September 28, 2007.

By-law Enforcement and Greater Sudbury Police Service were contacted to determine if any noise complaints were received. By-law Enforcement advised that their office received two complaints regarding noise from work being conducted during the evening hours at the Rainbow Centre on August 2nd and 3rd of this year. One of the By-law Enforcement Officers spoke to the contractor performing the work who advised that some of the renovations they were doing would require sandblasting during evening hours. Rainbow Centre have advised that sandblasting has not taken place since the complaints were received and are requesting approval of the noise exemption.
