

#### **BACKGROUND:**

In recognition of a surplus of funds for the 2007 Ontario Bus Replacement Program (OBRP), the Ministry wishes to support the capital costs of replacing transit buses and to provide additional funding to the Municipality.

For the City of Sudbury this represents \$176,523 in addition to the \$599,363 previously provided OBRP funding for 2007.

The Ministry and the Municipality entered into a letter of agreement, dated March 22, 2007, whereby the Ministry agreed to provide a maximum funding amount to the Municipality, subject to certain conditions, towards the capital costs of replacing transit buses.

The distribution of surplus OBRP funds requires the execution of an Amended Letter of Agreement, as the total OBRP payout will now be in excess of the original allocation amount. As with the original letter of agreement a supporting municipal by-law is also required.

Signed copies of the Amending Letter of Agreement and any necessary authorizing municipal bylaw are to be forwarded to the Provincial Transit Policy Office, NO LATER THAN MARCH 14, 2008 to be eligible for the additional OBRP funding.

Once the Ministry has received the signed copies of this Amending Letter of Agreement and any necessary authorizing municipal by-law, the Ministry will make arrangements for the payment of additional OBRP funding to the Municipality.
