



## Division Review

Manager of Financial Planning and Policy**BACKGROUND**

Upon passage of the amended by-law, most miscellaneous user fees will be increased by the rate of inflation as per Council policy. The inflationary factor is determined by the September Consumer Price Index, which was 3.4 percent.

The current policy and by-law applies to all user fees with the exception of water, wastewater, waste management, building services and police fees, which are covered under different by-laws.

Some recreational user fees will reflect the inflationary increase effective April 1, 2006 or September 1, 2006 to coincide with the playing season. In September of 2006 the harmonization of the arenas will be complete. In addition, play field and pool rates continue to be increased in a manner to achieve harmonization across the City. As a result of the acceptance of a budget option in the 2006 Current Budget, harmonization of community hall rates will take place as well.

Some crypt fees at the Mausoleum have been decreased as a result of market conditions.

Some fees will not be increased as they may adversely affect revenue generation. The transit passes have not been increased for 2006 as staff suggest that increases in 2006 rates would have a negative effect on ridership. Other changes to fees are too costly to the operation, such as parking fees which would not generate sufficient revenue to cover off the additional costs of new signage.

The schedule also reflects omissions and corrections of some incidental fees. As well, the definitions for juniors and seniors have been revised to ensure consistency throughout the City for all user fees. A junior refers to a child between the ages of 6 and 13 years, and a senior is defined as an individual 55 years of age or older.

Since most general fees are rounded to the closest dollar, there may be no increase in 2006 for some fees, as the adjustment would be minimal. In other cases the increase may be greater than the inflation rate, as the fee has been adjusted for the first time in many years, thus incorporating years of inflation.

WHEREAS this report sets out the proposed allocation of the combined City funding of \$433,563 and (reimbursable) Provincial CHPP funding of \$53,619, and is intended to encompass the allocation set out in Resolution 2005-372;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that bylaw 2005-306, which implemented resolution 2005-372 be repealed;

AND BE IT RESOLVED that the necessary bylaw be passed to authorize the making of grants to the organizations, in the amounts and for the purposes set out in this report, for the period January 1, 2006 to June 30, 2006.

**Background**

In anticipation of further funding from the Federal and/or Provincial Governments, Council authorized the expenditure on Homelessness initiatives for the first six months of 2006 through an allocation of \$255,541 from the reserves as outlined in the report to Council dated November and set out in bylaw 2005-306; and subsequent through authorizing a further one time budget enhancement of \$160, 536.

Additionally, the City has allocated in its base budget, the sum of \$34,974 for the year, of which half or \$17,487 has been allocated for the first six months of the year.

The City also receives provincial funding for homeless purposes. The Provincial Consolidated Homelessness Prevention Fund reimburses 100% of funding spent to facilitate the development of a seamless program of support services to connect individuals and their families to community resources and assist households experiencing or at-risk of homelessness to find and keep stable living arrangements. The City is entitled to be reimbursed up to a maximum of \$107,237 through this program, for a one year period, upon spending an equal amount. The City is including one half of this annual allocation, or \$53,619 as part of the allocation shown on the attached schedule. There is no net cost to the City of engaging in this expenditure.

It is proposed that the total amount of the City and Provincial funding for the period January 1, 2006 to June 30, 2006 be allocated as follows. This allocation is in accordance with the priorities of the Community Solutions Team, which priorities were approved in principle by Council.

At its meeting on January 11, 2006, the GSDC board approved the recommendation of the CED Committee to support Le Salon du livre du Grand Sudbury , 2006 edition.

Le salon du livre du Grand Sudbury Inc. is organizing the second bi-annual French language book fair and exposition for Sudbury on May 4 -7, 2006. This event was very successfully completed as a pilot project in 2004, attracting extensive attendance and media attention. It serves to establish Sudbury as an important centre for French language culture. More than 20,000 are expected to participate in 2006. The overall budget for the project is \$363,500.

The organization has requested \$50,000 in support from the City of Greater Sudbury to cover operational costs associated with facility rental, parking, programming and hosting a local promotional bus. A summary of the organization's mission and objectives is attached.

# Business Overview

## Business History

LE SALON DU LIVRE DU GRAND SUDBURY has been initiated by a team of volunteers with the support of the CENTRE FORA and its director Yolande Clément. Its first activity was to organise the "First Edition" of the SALON DU LIVRE DU GRAND SUDBURY in May of 2004.

## Vision and Mission Statement

LE SALON DU LIVRE DU GRAND SUDBURY has, according to its Charter which was obtained October 4th, 2005, adopted the following mission:

Le Salon du livre du Grand Sudbury Inc. is an organization established to:

1- to promote education in the French language through reading and cultural activities designed according to diverse francophone literary products; and

2- develop knowledge, in the French language, by encouraging meetings, cultural exchanges, conferences and educational workshops.

"LE SALON DU LIVRE DU GRAND SUDBURY is the most important cultural event in Northern Ontario."

There are few activities of this magnitude in Northern Ontario which francophone literature and reading. Worse yet, there are very few distributors of French language reading material in this vast territory, home to over 210 000 francophones and francophiles. Practically isolated from the world of books, the French language readership in Northern Ontario is virtually a virgin territory.

Inspired by the success LE SALON DU LIVRE DE HEARST (2000 and 2002) in Hearst, Ontario, the francophone community created LE SALON DU LIVRE DU GRAND SUDBURY in 2004.

Le **Salon du livre du Grand Sudbury** which will take place from the 4th to the 7th of May 2006, is becoming the most important francophone cultural event in Northern Ontario.

## **Objectives**

The objectives, written and approved by the Board are as follows:

- 1- To offer direct promotion of French language books in an area where no general library of such exists;
- 2- To place French language books, in all their diversity, in the public domain;
- 3- To promote reading and a place for French language books in a minority setting;
- 4- To create a context where writer and audience, young and old, can exchange freely;
- 5- To offer to Franco-Ontarian editing houses and authors the opportunity to make their works known to their primary public;
- 6- To encourage professional contacts between editors, libraries, distributors, librarians and teachers;
- 7- To strengthen the francophone presence in Sudbury and enhance its radiance;
- 8- To encourage the economic development of the City of Greater Sudbury through the arts;
- 9- To rally the artistic and cultural organizations around a common event;
- 10- To create a resonating impact in Downtown Sudbury during the event.

## **Ownership**

LE SALON DU LIVRE DU GRAND SUDBURY INC. is a non-profit organization which is directed by a seven (7) member Board of Directors: President, Mireille Groleau; Vice-president, Stéphane Gauthier; Secretary, Kim Morris; Treasurer, Lyn Lebeau; and three Administrators: Alain Gélinas, Gratien Allaire, Melchior MBonimpa.

The bi-annual event and all related activities are presented in cooperation with our partners at agreed upon locations by all parties.
