Background

In 2005 The Ministry of Health and Long Term Care announced funding to implement 150 Family Health Teams throughout the Province of Ontario. A submission was submitted and was successful, hence the creation of the City of Lakes Family Health Team (CoLFHT), which is a partnership between: the Northern Ontario School of Medicine, the Hôpital Régional Sudbury Regional Hospital and the City of Greater Sudbury.

The locations of the sites identified for the City of Lakes Family Health team reflect the city's commitment to enhancing the delivery of primary care to those areas most affected by the shortage of family medicine practitioners and they include: Pioneer Manor/Seniors' Campus, and the former town halls in Rayside Balfour, Valley East and Walden.

Progress to date:

July 2007	Appointment of project manager - David Courtemanche
September 2007	First meeting of the CoLFHT interim steering committee

Pioneer Manor/Seniors' Campus site:

May 2007	Submission of preliminary drawings, proposed budget, functional program and project schedule to Ministry of Health and Long Term for technical review and approval.
June 2007	Technical Review completed & approved - proceed to construction drawings.
September 2007	Construction drawings finalized and approved by CoLFHT followed by submission to MoHLTC for approval to go to tender.

Proposed occupancy date: April 2008

Total construction cost: \$ 1,254,000.00 (50-50 cost share between Ministry of Health and Long Term Care and the City of Greater Sudbury).

The funding for this project is included in the Pioneer Manor redevelopment capital fund.

Valley East site:

September 2007	CoLFHT approve the floor plan for the Valley East site
September 2007	Submission of preliminary drawings, proposed budget, functional program and project schedule to Ministry of Health and Long Term for technical review and approval.
	Proposed occupancy date: April 2008

Proposed construction cost: \$244,000.00
Funding for this project is secured through monies set aside for the turnkey development of this site.

Rayside Balfour & Walden
