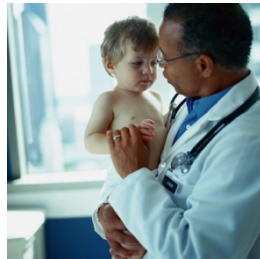

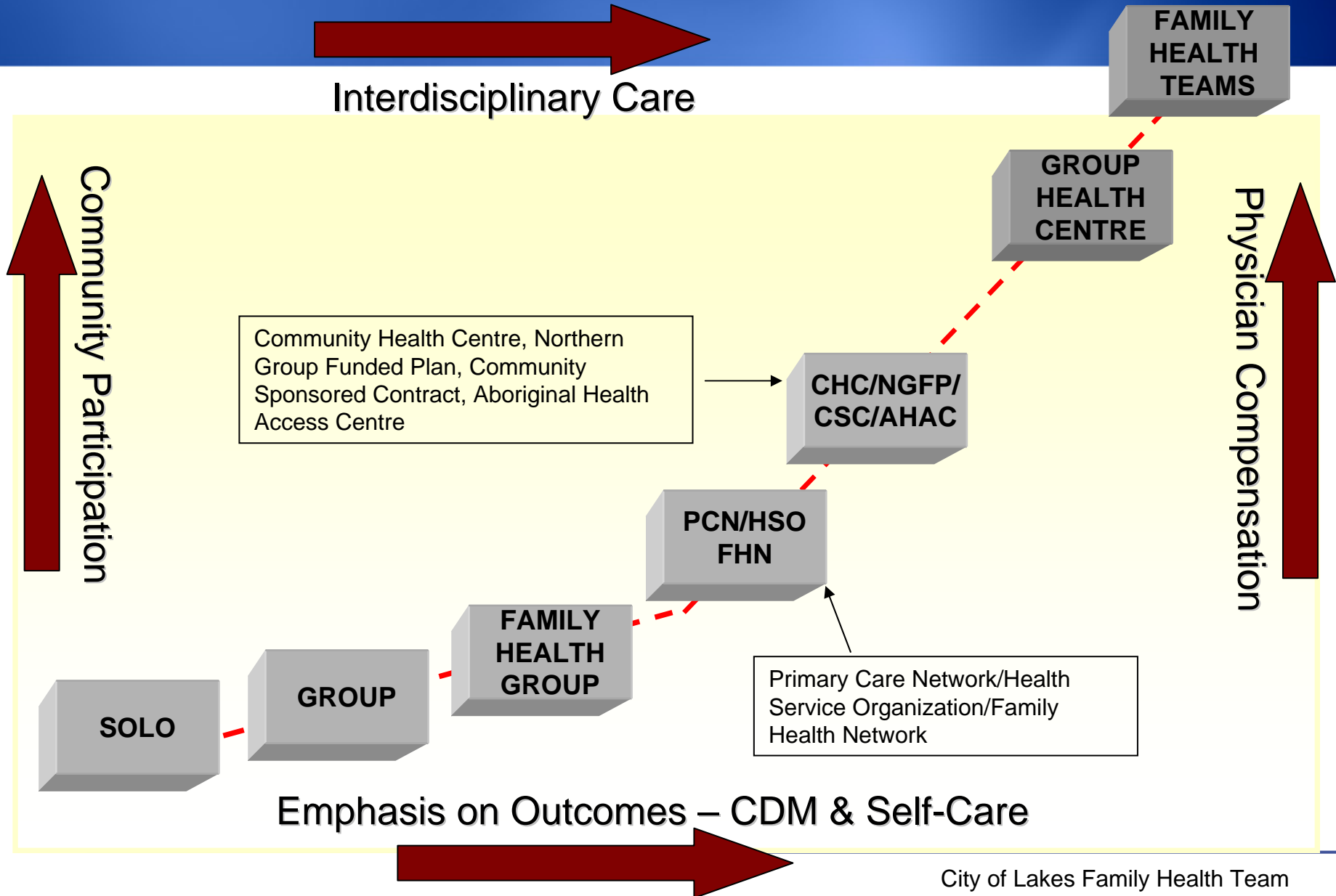
- ***Family Health Teams are part of a continuum of Primary Care Reform***

Comparison of Primary Health Care Models



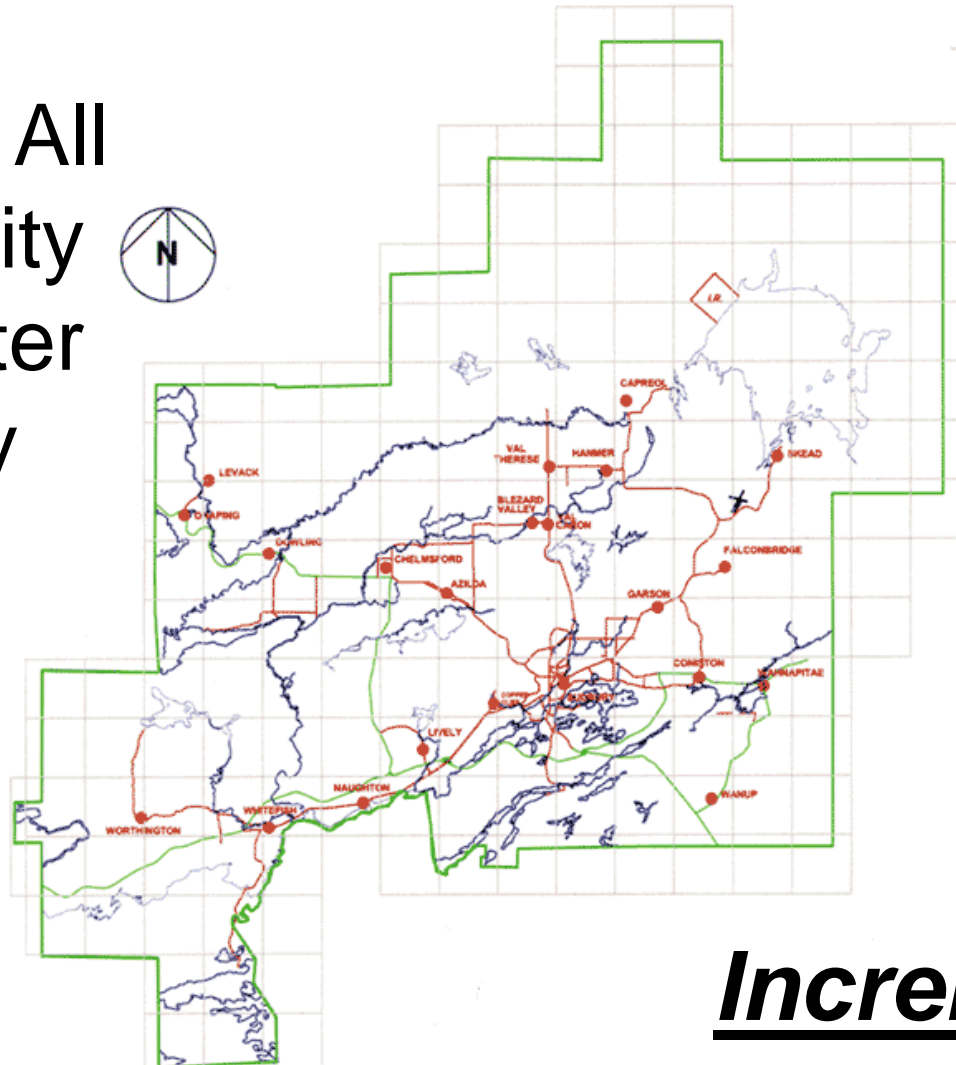

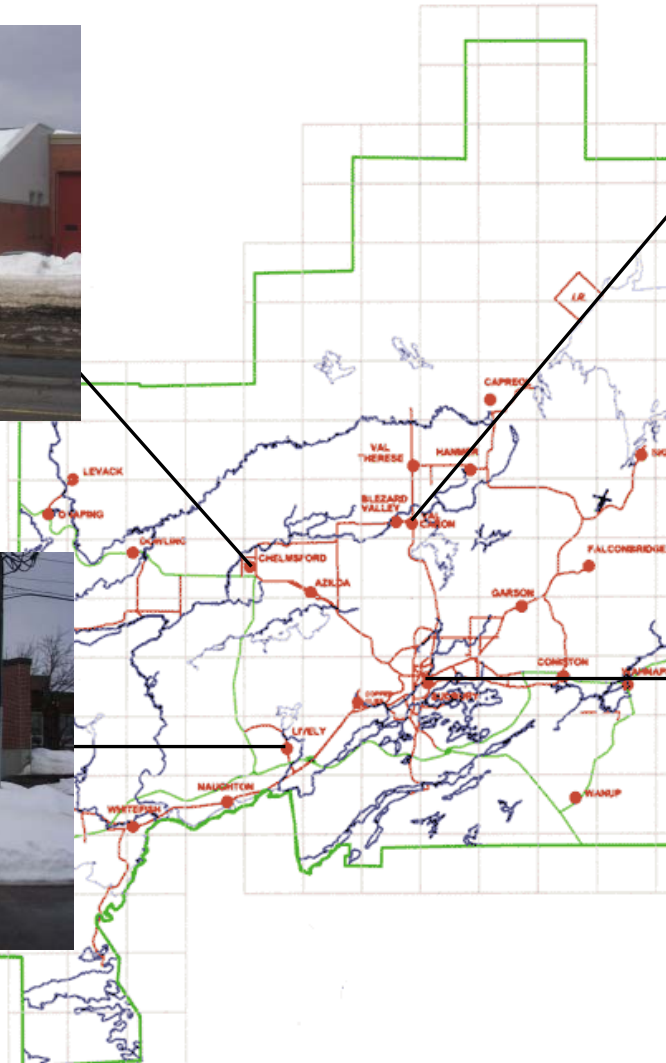

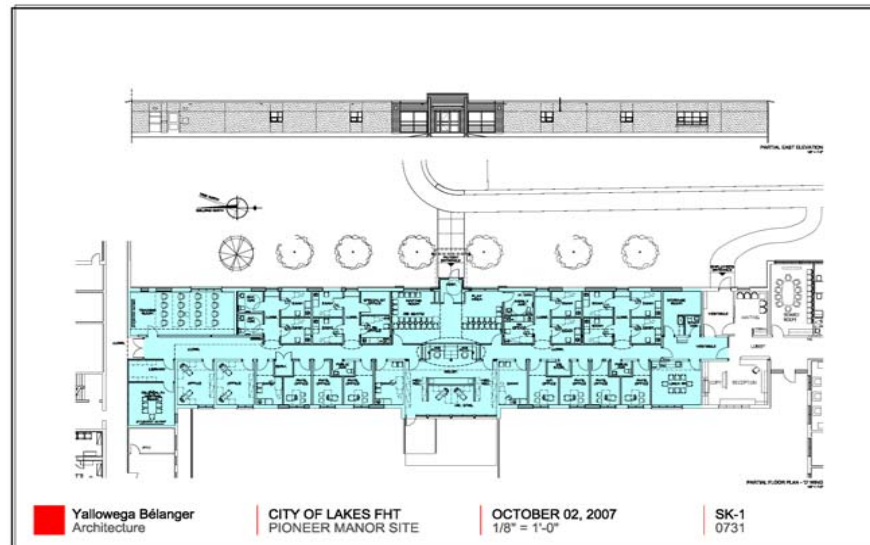

 - Approval to Proceed to Tender!

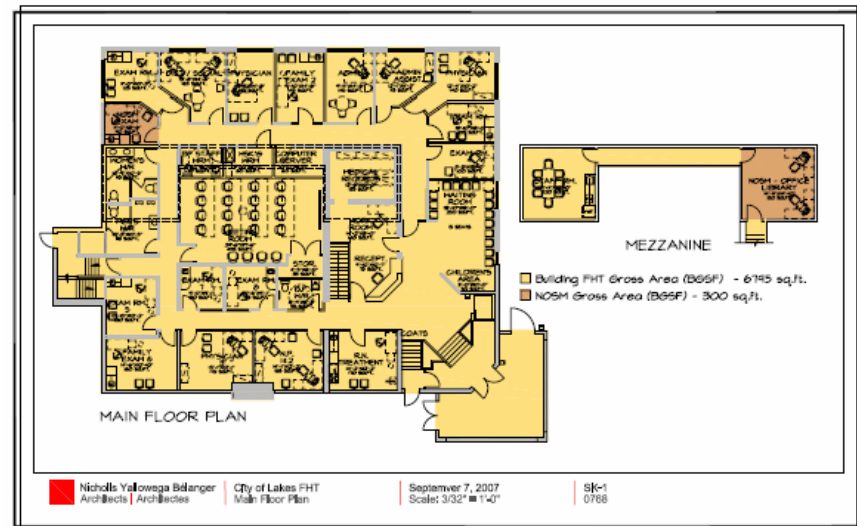


Val Caron Site Plan



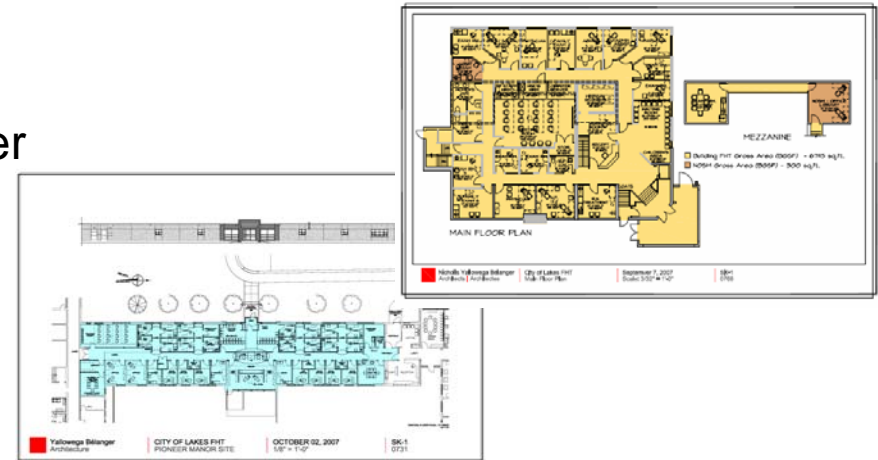
Val Caron Site Plan: status

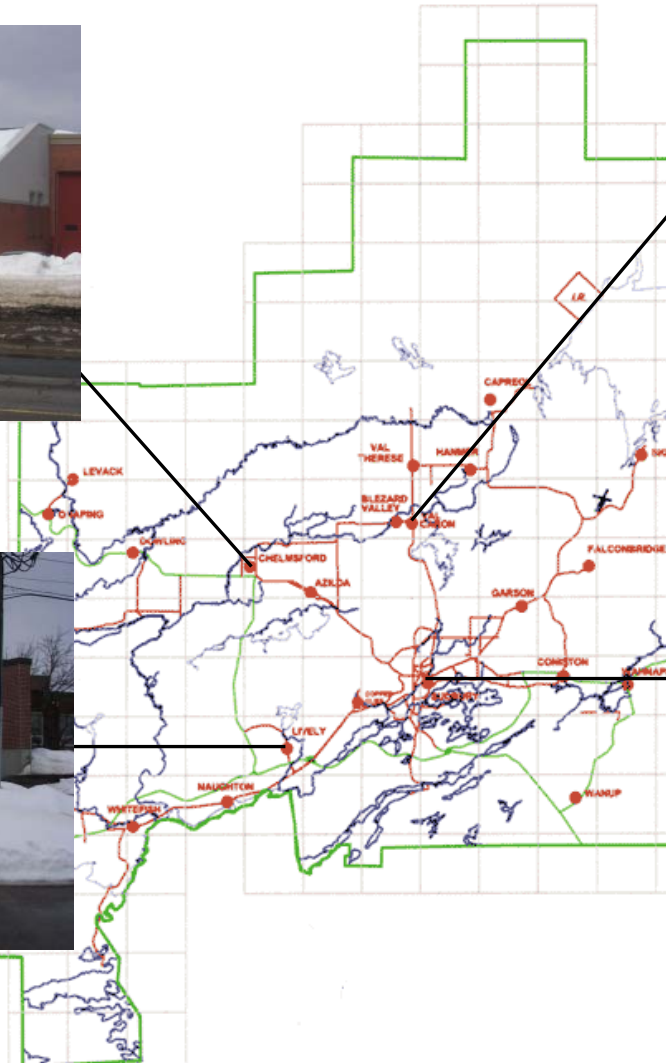
