BACKGROUND

In the wake of Enron, Nortel and similar situations, there have been recent changes to auditing standards. These changes dictate that an annual audit plan be discussed with members of the audit committee. In the absence of an audit committee, the auditor is required to communicate to those with oversight responsibility, which in the case of the City of Greater Sudbury is the Finance Committee. The objective of the Audit Plan is to identify audit areas and systems that will be reviewed during the audit, explain the audit approach to be used, provide information with respect to the scope and timing of the audit and identify specific issues for the year under review.

Our auditors will be presenting the Audit Planning report with respect to the 2004 year-end to the Finance Committee on January 26, 2005. Their presentation will cover the following topics:

- Audit deliverables
- Key responsibilities regarding Financial Statement Reporting
- Understanding financial reporting risks
- Scope of the audit
- Auditor Independence
- Audit methodology
- Audit schedule
- Current developments and accounting issues.

Wayne McDonald from KPMG will be presenting on behalf of Collins Barrow Maheu Noiseux / FCR (Freelandt Caldwell Reilly) / KPMG.
