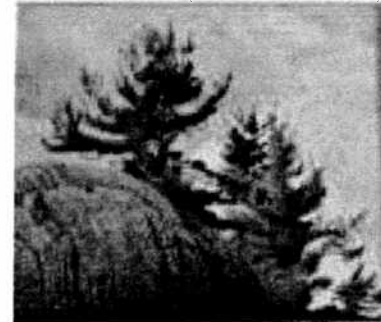

- Photography is one of the most popular artistic activities in our community.



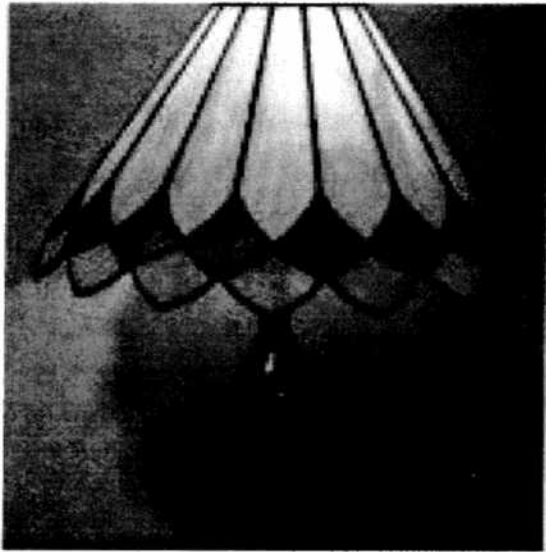

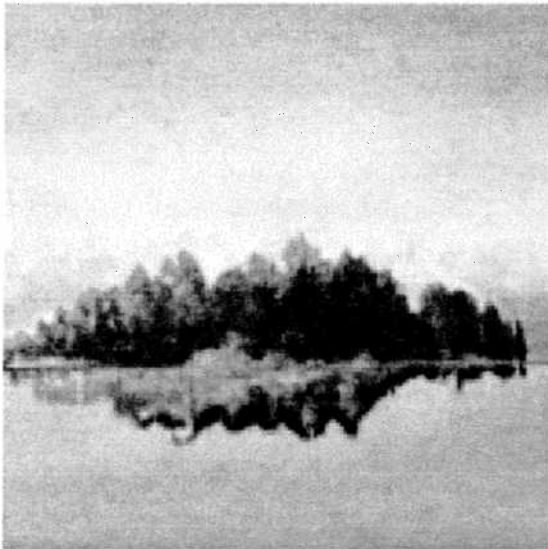

- We have about 300 lakes in Sudbury and photographs can make this beauty much more central to our lives.



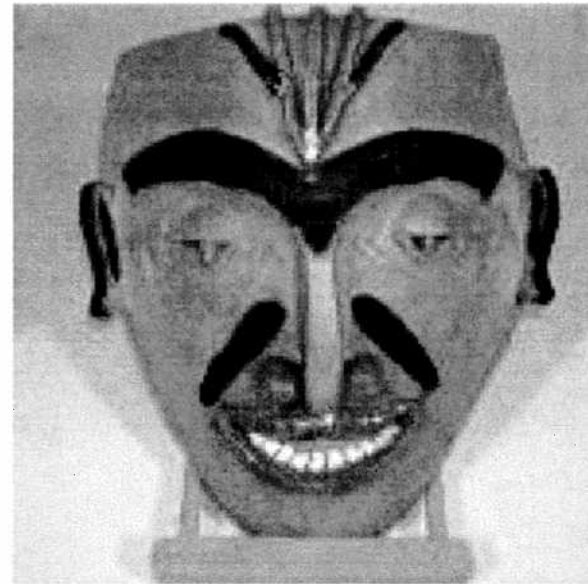

- Photographs can be duplicated, sent by email, added to a website, enlarged or reduced – they are easy to share.



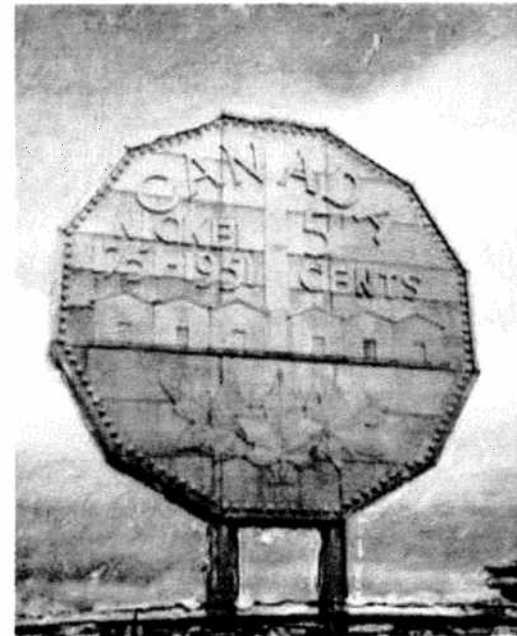

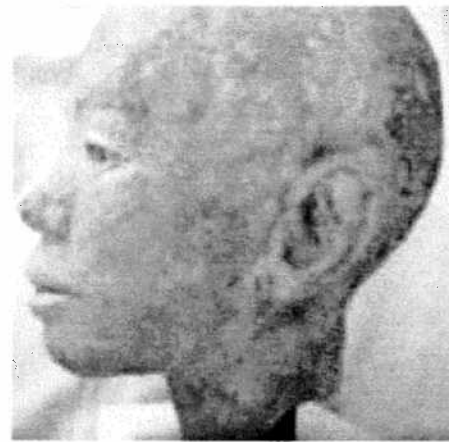
