Roles and Responsibilities

- the committee will solicit the citizens of the city in an open manner, for an appropriate name for the bridge (by a contest or other method)
- the national flag of any permanent resident of Sudbury may be flown on the bridge without restrictions
- the flags will be placed on the bridge by way of a lottery insuring fairness for all
- flags will be replaced once a year to ensure their best appearance. Torn flags will be replaced immediately
- the cultural group/person(s) responsible for the flag will be responsible for it's initial cost and for yearly replacement/maintenance cost. Once a flag has been donated to the Flag Committee it will remain under their sole direction and control



Roles and Responsibilities cont'd

- the committee will inform the general public through the media well in advance of the commencement of this project to enable everyone who wishes to fly their flag time to make arrangements
- this committee will endure no cost or liability for this project
- from time to time the committee may suggest to the city additional ways to enhance the heritage flag display on the bridge i.e. floral display etc.
