BACKGROUND

Despite every effort being made to ensure that items budgeted for in the Operating Budget are received/completed by year-end, there are inevitably a few areas that cannot be finalized and funds must be set aside to complete ongoing budgeted projects. These projects must still be completed, and this will occur in 2008.

Reserve Details

Administrative Services - \$50,000

Accessibility Planning is underspent by approximately \$50,000 and this is an ongoing project with the reserved amount being required in 2008.

Human Resources - \$46,500

Legal Services related to the current Fire Services negotiations are required to be reserved in order to be available in 2008. In addition, the expenses related to the move of some Human Resources staff to the Tom Davies Annex have not yet been realized and the funds must be reserved for use in 2008.

Economic Development - \$57,000

There is a commitment for software development relative to the mysudbury.ca portal. This amount will be reserved to fund the requirements in 2008.

Physician Recruitment - \$19,000

The requirement to attract and retain physicians remains high in our community and surplus funds in 2007 will be required in 2008, therefore must be reserved.

Lake Water Quality - \$15,000

This is an ongoing project, and the funding will be added to the 2008 budget.

Environmental Planning Initiatives - \$10,000

A plan to equip ambulances with hydrogen fuel injection systems was not undertaken in 2007. As a result, approximately \$10,000 must be reserved so this project can proceed in 2008.

Financial Services - \$182,000

A number of projects ranging from the Municipal Management Maintenance System process review, policy reviews such as Capital and Infrastructure Financing Policies, ERP projects such as the development of a new Chart of Accounts, ERP training and equipment and furniture needs for the Finance Division were not completed in 2007, and therefore the funding will be required for 2008.

Community Development - General Manager's Office - \$53,500

Renovations to the Capreol Citizens Service Centre required to accommodate a physician who is relocating his practice to Capreol were not completed in 2007. In addition the scoreboard purchased for James Jerome Field in 2007 was not installed, and therefore funds must be reserved to be used in 2008. Also, some funds dedicated to geriatrician recruitment in 2007 were not expensed and will be required in 2008 for this project. A small renovation of office space is also required, which was not completed in 2007. In total, the amount to be reserved is approximately \$53,500.

Leisure and Recreation Services - \$47,000

Grants to Rainbow Routes and to the Youth Centres for 2007 have been withheld and will be required in 2008 to assist in funding these operations.

Water Services - \$60,000

The work on the installation of four hydrants on Montee Principale approved in the 2007 budget has not yet been undertaken. This amount must be reserved and will be utilized in 2008 for this project.

Infrastructure - \$45,500

Renovations to restructure the Municipal Management Maintenance System Division offices did not take place in 2007. In addition, the safety audit for the Tanguay/D'youville/St. Anne stairway was not undertaken, therefore these funds are required to be reserved for use in 2008.

Police Services - \$45,000

As a result of delays in the Citizens on Patrol (COPS) signage, clothing and miscellaneous items, these expenditures did not take place in 2007 and funds will be required for 2008.

In total, approximately \$630,000 from the 2007 budget needs to be reserved for projects underway. The related expenditures will take place in 2008. It should be noted that these items were projected to be fully spent when the corporate year-end position was estimated for 2007. Reserving the funds will not have a negative impact on this projection.

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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Manager of Financial Planning & Policy

This report updates the expenditure level that would qualify for an exemption from mandatory connections to water and wastewater systems in accordance with policy. Owners are exempt from mandatory connections to water/wastewater services, if together with other conditions, the costs to establish the private portion of each connection exceeds a specified limit. The limit is increased annually in direct proportion to increases in the composite component of the Canadata Construction Index for Ontario, using November 15th of each year over the previous year. The 2008 limit is \$9,450 which is a 4.6% increase over (2007 over 2006).

BACKGROUND

Some by-laws of the former Regional Municipality of Sudbury remain in effect under the new City of Greater Sudbury, including By-laws 87-340 and 87-341 requiring owners to connect to sewer and water works.

These by-laws make provision for exemptions from mandatory connections to sewer and water services based on a number of conditions. One of the conditions is cost of connections, which is increased annually.

These by-laws will not affect any properties in the annexed areas, as no sewer or water services are available.

Owners are exempt from mandatory connections to water/wastewater services, if together with other conditions, the costs to establish the private portion of **each** connection exceeds a specified limit. The limit is increased annually in direct proportion to increases in the Composite Component of the Canadata Construction Index, Ontario series, using November 15th of each year, over the previous year.

The increase for 2007 over 2006 is 4.6 percent.

Therefore, for 2008, exemptions from mandatory connections are available if, together with other conditions, the costs to establish the private portion of each connection exceeds \$9,450.
