RE: Temporary Amendment to Noise By-Law for work on our bridge traversing Frood Road and Beatty Street of the Former city of Sudbury.

To Whom It May Concern:

Starting November 01 2005, I will have a Bridges and Structures Steel Bridge Gangs Mobilizing into the City of Sudbury to undertake structural steel repairs on our bridge mile 6.1 Sudbury Spur. This bridge located on our Sudbury spur traverse's Frood road and Beatty Street.

This will be phase 2 of this project, the gang will work at this location for the remainder of their 2005 program November through to the end of December 2005. Our Bridges & Structures gangs work an 8 & 6, work cycle Tuesday to Tuesday. During the period of November 01 through to December 23, 2005 we will have two gangs working the following shifts.

 Gangs will work back-to-back 8&6 Tuesday-to-Tuesday A & B cycles for continuous coverage at this location up to and including December 23 2005.

- November 01 to November 08, 2005 07:30 until 17:30 shift. (B cycle)
- November 08 to December 15, 2005 07:30 until 17:30 shift. (A cycle)
- November 15 to November 22. 2005 07:30 until 17:30 shift. (B cycle)
- November 22 to November 29 2005 07:00 until 17:30 shift. (A cycle)
- November 29 to December 06 2005 07:00 until 17:30 shift (B cycle)
- December 06 to December 13 2005 07:00 until 17:30 shift (A cycle)
- December 13 to December 20 2005 07:00 until 17:30 shift (B cycle)
- December 20 to December 27 2005 07:00 until 17:30 gang will shut down at the end of their shift December 23 and return December 29 2005 and demobilize the site.

CN. Rail recognizes that in order to undertake these repairs; It's Bridges & Structures Gangs work cycles that involve weekend work it would require a temporary amendment to the Former City of Sudbury's Noise by-laws. Could you put this on the city Councils agenda at your earliest convenience?
