Background:

A tender package was prepared for the purchase of four (4) 2007 or 2008 Cab & Chassis complete with Dump Box.

The vendor bids were received and opened on Tuesday March 27, 2007:

The Manager of Fleet Services assessed the bids and determined that the lowest priced bid was non-compliant and must be rejected due to its failure to meet tender specifications. The failure points are as follows:

- The quoted vehicle had a wheel base of 24" less than specified. This results in undesirable ride characteristics and operator discomfort.
- The quoted vehicle is offered with a six (6) cylinder diesel, where an eight (8) cylinder diesel was specified.
- The quoted vehicle could not be supplied with a limited slip differential as specified. This affects the traction and driveability of the vehicle in construction type conditions.
- The quoted vehicle was a Cab Forward (cab over the engine) design and a regular cab design was specified. This affects the ride of the vehicle and the comfort of the driver and passengers.
- The quoted vehicle is not equipped with driver and passenger air bags as specified. This is an employee safety issue and completely unacceptable.

The next lowest priced bid met all of the required specifications and staff is recommending award to Cambrian Ford Sales Inc. in the amount of \$206,360.00, plus applicable taxes (\$235,250.46, including taxes).
