




Background:

Tenders for Contract IES 07-19, Madison Avenue Culvert Replacement and Sanitary and Watermain Improvements, were opened at the Tender Opening Committee meeting on Wednesday, May 9, 2007 as follows:

A review of the tenders indicated that lowest tender, Lacroix Construction Co. (Sudbury) Ltd. (\$ 559,105.48), contained several mathematical errors leading to a revised total tender amount of \$ 668,971.38. Lacroix Construction Co. (Sudbury) Ltd. was advised of the errors in their bid submission.

The lowest tender meeting all contract specifications was submitted by Adventure Construction Ltd. in the amount of \$ 577,018.92 and is recommended for approval.

This project is part of the City's COMRIF III Program and is funded from the 2007 Approved Capital Roads Budget.
