- Contractor and City Crews to complete work by May 5








Weekly Bulky Item Collection

- Bring it to the Household Hazardous Waste Depot or call the *Toxic Taxi* for free home collection service.










Leaf and Yard Trimmings Collection

- There is no limit on other household waste.








