Mayor and Council Roundtable on Seniors' Issues & the Seniors Campus Steering Committee The following resolution was presented:

2004-29 Callaghan-Caldarelli: WHEREAS the Mayor and Council Committee on Seniors Issues and the Seniors Campus Steering Committee are both individual committees that gather regularly to discuss similar issues pertaining to the health and well-being of seniors in our community;

AND WHEREAS an opportunity now exists to combine the Mayor and Council Committee on Seniors Issues and the Seniors Campus Steering Committee;
