

BY-LAW 2012-242

**A BY-LAW OF THE CITY OF GREATER SUDBURY
TO SUBMIT CERTAIN QUESTIONS TO THE
ELECTORS IN THE 2014 MUNICIPAL ELECTION**

WHEREAS the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*, S.O. 1996, c. 32, Sched., authorizes the council of a municipality to pass a bylaw to submit to its electors, a question not otherwise authorized by law, but within the council's jurisdiction;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, a municipality has authority under Section 148 to require that retail business establishments be closed to the public at any time;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the City of Greater Sudbury has determined that it is desirable to pass a by-law to submit certain questions to the electors of the City of Greater Sudbury as part of the 2014 municipal election;


**NOW THEREFORE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREATER SUDBURY
HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS**

1. Each of the following questions shall be put to the electors of the City of Greater Sudbury as part of the 2014 municipal election:
 - (a) Are you in favor of retail business establishments opening on December 26?;
 - (b) Are you in favor of retail business establishments opening on the Civic Holiday, the first Monday in August?; and
 - (c) Are you in favor of allowing retail business establishments to set their opening hours?


2. The Clerk of the City of Greater Sudbury is authorized to give notice of the passage of this by-law to the public and to the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing, in accordance with the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*.

3. This By-law shall come into full force and effect upon passage.
