

By-law 2021-166

**A By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Amend By-law 2021-111
being a By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Regulate
the Erection of Signs and Advertising Devices**

Whereas Council for the City of Greater Sudbury wishes to amend By-law 2021-111 being a By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Regulate the Erection of Signs and Advertising Devices;

Now therefore Council of the City of Greater Sudbury hereby enacts as follows:

1. By-law 2021-111 being a By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Regulate the Erection of Signs and Advertising Devices is hereby amended by repealing paragraphs 53(3) and 53(4) and enacting the following paragraphs 53(3) and 53(4) in their place and stead:

“53 (3) No Person shall Erect, cause or authorize a Portable Sign to be Erected or continue to be Erected if it would result in:

- (a) more Portable Signs on a Property than the number identified in Column 2 of Table 14 below for a Property which has a Street Line length set out in on the same line in Column 1; or
- (b) more Portable Signs on a Property in a calendar year than the number identified in Column 3 of Table 14 below for a Property which has a Street Line length as set out on the same line in Column 1 for that Property; or
- (c) both Portable Signs and Flag Signs being Erected on the same Property.


(4) No Person shall Erect, cause or authorize a Flag Sign to be Erected or continue to be Erected if it would result in:

- (a) more Flag Signs on a Property than the number identified in Column 4 of Table 14 below for a Property which has a Street Line length set out in on the same line in Column 1; or
- (b) more Flag Signs on a Property in a calendar year than the number identified in Column 5 of Table 14 below for a Property which has a Street Line length as set out on the same line in Column 1 for that Property.

2. This By-law comes into full force and effect upon passage.
