

BY-LAW 2013-93

**A BY-LAW OF THE CITY OF GREATER SUDBURY TO AMEND
BY-LAW 2012-242 BEING A BY-LAW TO SUBMIT CERTAIN QUESTIONS
TO THE ELECTORS IN THE 2014 MUNICIPAL ELECTION**

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Greater Sudbury passed By-law 2012-242 being A By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Submit Certain Questions to the Electors of the City of Greater Sudbury as part of the 2014 municipal election;

AND WHEREAS the City has received an Order from the Office of the Chief Electoral Officer of Ontario to amend the wording of the questions in By-law 2012-242;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the City of Greater Sudbury wishes to amend By-law 2012-242 to reflect the Order of the Chief Electoral Officer;

**NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREATER SUDBURY
HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. By-law 2012-242 is hereby amended by repealing Section 1 and replacing the following Section 1 in its place and stead:


“1. Each of the following questions shall be put to the electors of the City of Greater Sudbury as part of the 2014 municipal election in accordance with the Order to the Chief Electoral Officer for Ontario dated May 21, 2013 :

- (a) Are you in favour of retail business establishments having the choice to open to the public on December 26?
- (b) Are you in favour of retail business establishments having the choice to open to the public on the Civic Holiday, the first Monday in August?


(c) Are you in favour of allowing retail business establishments to choose the hours when they are open to the public?

2. Section 2 of By-law 2012-242 is hereby repealed.
3. This By-law shall come into force and effect upon passage.
