The Clerk/Returning Officer for the City of Greater Sudbury is responsible for conducting the election for the Mayor, Councillors and District School Board Trustees.

The District School Board Offices encompass areas beyond the boundary of the City of Greater Sudbury. The election summary includes the registered voters and voter turnout for the City of Greater Sudbury as well as the outlying unorganized townships and municipalities for which the election is being conducted.

The number of eligible registered voters for the City of Greater Sudbury is 127,783 with a total of 55,161 voters which represents a 43.17 percent voter turnout.

The number of eligible registered voters for the City of Greater Sudbury and the outlying unorganized townships and municipalities is 137,107 with a total of 55,963 voters which represents a 40.82 percent voter turnout.

La greffière et directrice du scrutin pour la Ville du Grand Sudbury est chargée de la tenue des élections pour les postes de maire, de conseillers municipaux et de conseillers scolaires de district.

Les conseils scolaires de district couvrent des endroits situés au-delà des limites de la Ville du Grand Sudbury. Le sommaire des élections reflète le nombre d'électeurs inscrits ainsi que le nombre d'électeurs ayant participé au scrutin dans la Ville du Grand Sudbury, dans les cantons environnants non érigés en municipalité et dans les municipalités environnantes pour lesquelles la Ville du Grand Sudbury a tenu l'élection.

Des 127 783 électeurs inscrits dans les limites de la Ville du Grand Sudbury, 55 161 ont voté. Cela représente une participation électorale de 43,17 % des électeurs admissibles.

Des 137 107 électeurs inscrits dans la Ville du Grand Sudbury et dans les cantons non érigés en municipalité et les autres municipalités environnantes, 55 973 ont participé au scrutin. Cela représente une participation électorale de 40,82 % des électeurs admissibles.
