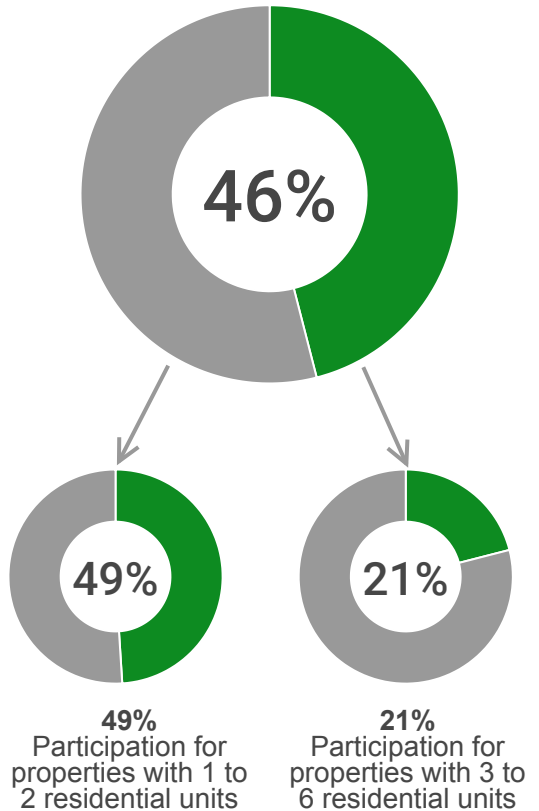

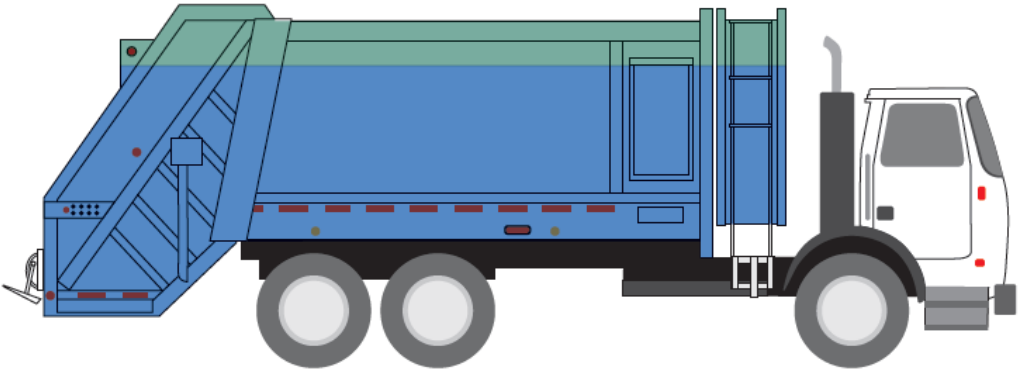

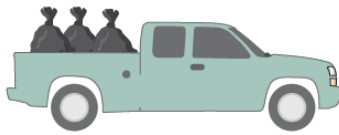
Landfill Quarterly Waste Density Data



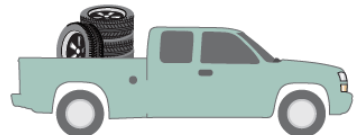

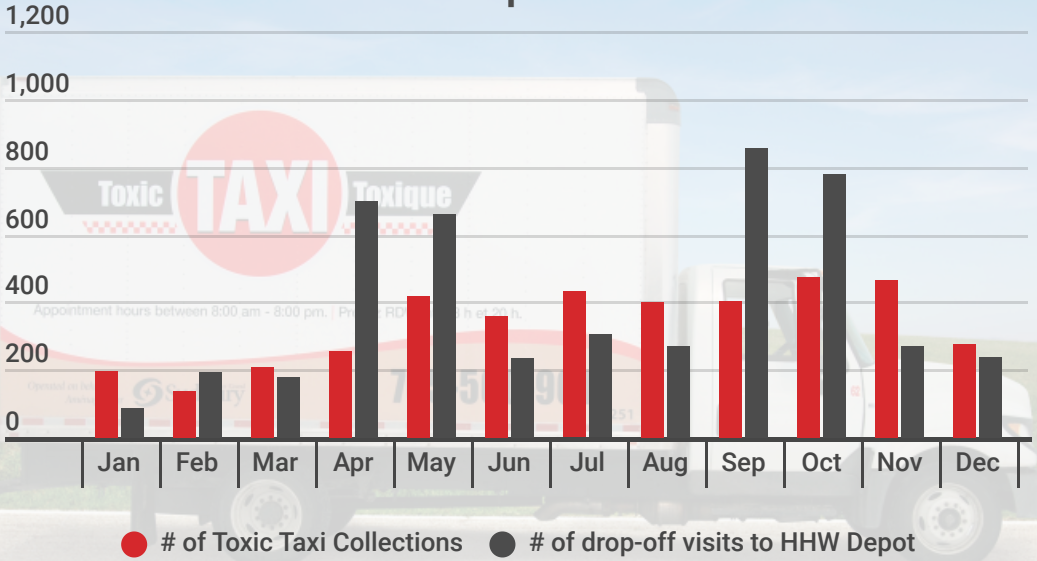
